The grants must be used for a youth-oriented program sponsored by the local unit such as athletic sponsorship, educational programs, etc. The specific type of program must be listed on the application. Youth Grant recipients must submit a picture and article for *The Policemen's Magazine* detailing how the grant was used within the year after receiving the grant to be eligible for future grants.

At the 1992 Convention, the State Executive Board made a recommendation that the Youth Grant should not be used in conjunction with an agency-sponsored program. The Board felt that the intent of the grant is to provide assistance to the local PB & PA Unit sponsored programs, and not to subsidize a program that is administered by a governmental agency.

At the 1996 Convention, a resolution was passed by the delegates present, which raised the amount of the grants. The resolution stated that local units could apply for a youth grant requesting up to \$1,000.

If you have sent your request in, please double check with the Springfield office. The master file will be kept at the office in Springfield and will be brought to the Convention for review by the Executive Board.
